I had the opportunity to attend a Veterans Day service at Frederick Memorial Park on November 11th, 2023, and was fortunate enough to meet several veterans from Ft. Detrick. Although it was somewhat chilly outside, the 45-minute event was over the top with several guest speakers and dignitaries throughout Frederick County and Maryland.

My traveling continues as the Caravan Team visited five American Legion Posts in Southern Maryland the weekend of October 21st, (Prince Frederick, Hughesville, Ridge, Lusby, and Chesapeake Beach). The team was welcomed with open arms at each post along with tours of their facilities. We had some extra time and decided to visit the VFW in Lexington Park. November was just as busy, with us visiting several posts in Baltimore County.

We are beginning to see multiple donations and fundraising events throughout the state for my Commander's Project to build a pavilion at the Southern Maryland Youth Camp.

I want to thank the entire Post 60 family for their support of the SAL SMR Drawdown on October 28th at Laurel Post 60. We raised \$6,000 for my project, and we hit an all-time high profit for this event.

I also want to thank Squadron 116 in Reisterstown for their Bull & Oyster event to raise funds for my project. The event was sold out and featured great food and music.

The next big fundraiser supporting my project will be the Detachment Drawdown that will be hosted by Squadron 135 in Perryville. The event is on March 2nd, 2024, from 3-7 PM at the Perryville Firehouse. Tickets are \$50 (admits two) and the event will be featuring horse races, money wheel, cake wheel, silent auction, pull tabs and more! The ticket also includes dinner and a limited open bar. 

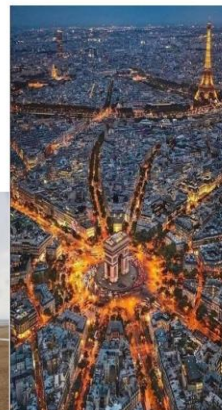

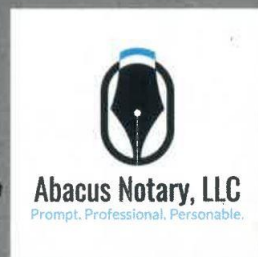
