Here's some additional information for the events:

Park anywhere in the Hourly Garage at the airport (try to park as close to the International Terminal as possible). Once inside the airport, go towards the International Terminal, meet in the lower lobby of that terminal. <u>Please bring your parking ticket with you and present to an Operation Welcome Home representative upon your arrival to get it validated.</u>

~ The estimated time commitment for this event is $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 hours.

~ The volunteers are to arrive at the event time however, that is not when the troops arrive. When you arrive you will be creating goodie bags for the arriving soldiers. If you wish to bring something for the goodie bags, please consider bringing handmade "thank you" cards from children or pre-packaged/single-serving snacks (cookies, crackers, granola bars, and candy) and ½ liter bottled water for the goodie bags. <u>Please do not bring homemade cookies, fresh fruit, or other perishable food items</u>. Most of the arriving troops are not local and will be waiting for a connecting flight and are hungry, thirsty, and tired.
